

## **Student Rules when using the IF-AT quiz**

1. All group members are required to participate in the activity, although it is beneficial for groups to assign roles at the start of the group activity, for example:
  - a. Reader - reads the questions to the other group members.
  - b. Moderator - keeps the discussions on track/time.
  - c. Scribe - summarises the group's discussion and answers.
  - d. Tabulator - keeps track of the group's score on the IF-AT form (in the score column) and tallies the score at the end of the quiz.
2. Advise groups of the rules for undertaking and scoring the quiz:
  - a. Groups should discuss and compare their individual answers to the quiz and come to an agreement as a group on which box to scratch off the IF-AT form.
  - b. A star symbol will indicate a correct answer; an incorrect answer will be blank.
  - c. If the group gets the answer wrong, they should discuss what they consider to be the next best answer and continue the process until the star is revealed for each of the quiz questions.
  - d. Advise of the scoring system for the quiz (e.g. 4 points for correct answer on first try, 3 points for correct answer on second try, 2 points for correct answer on third try, 1 point for correct answer on fourth try, 0 points for correct answer on fifth try)
  - e. Scratching 'tools' can include coins, plastic student ID, pen tops, keys, credit cards etc.
  - f. Advise the groups that they have approx. 15-20 minutes to complete the IF-AT form.
